Barbara G. Wheeler is the former director of the Auburn Theological Seminary's Center for the Study of Theological Education, which she founded in 1991 while serving as Auburn's president—a post that she held for thirty years. She is currently serving as a consultant at Lilly Endowment Inc. She is principal author of numerous research reports on theological education and has contributed to and edited a dozen volumes on the future of mainline Protestantism, congregational studies, and theological education. She is the coauthor of *Being There: Culture and Formation in Two Theological Schools* (Oxford Press). Wheeler is a ruling elder in the United Church of Granville, New York. She was a charter member of the board of the Covenant Network of Presbyterians, a member of the Theological Task Force on the Peace, Unity and Purity of the Church, and a member of the Presbyterian Committee on Congregational Song (PCOCS) that compiled the new hymnal, *Glory to God*.
